



WALKING MAP OF HISTORIC MONONA

Before this location was discovered as a historical land mark it sat on George Nichols Property and was only found during road surveys in 1944. Outlet Mound looks over Lake Monona and Yahara River and is an important part of the community as it represents Native American ceremonial sites.

Tonyawatha Springs Hotel -Historical Land Mark

Year Built: 1885

The house on the property was built in 1879, in 1885 the property added the hotel, during this time tourists were able to enjoy the area and the natural springs. The Ho-Chunk found this Natural Resource of great value pre-settlement. Tonyawatha Springs Hotel burned to the ground in 1895.










